Definitions:

- The overall continuation rate is the proportion of individuals in wave 1 who have been interviewed in wave 2 (e.g. individuals in wave 2/individuals in wave 1 \*100).
- The continuation rate by sex or age is the proportion of individuals in the age or sex category in wave 1 who have been interviewed in wave 2 (e.g. women in wave 2/women in wave 1 \*100). Variables "asex" and "aage" were used for the determination of the sex and age categories respectively.
